Background

The Health Connector IT team seeks approval to enter into a work order with McInnis Consulting for the services of a Data Architect through the state blanket contract ITS77 for Staff Augmentation.

Scope of Work

- The Data Architect, who is an employee of Tekizma, Inc. (which subcontracts to the Health Connector (CCA) through statewide contract ITS77), and has been working effectively with the Health Connector's IT team for several years and will continue to support the advancement of our Enterprise Data Warehouse (EDW), analytics, and reporting platforms
- This includes data architecture, data modeling and design, data security, analytics and reporting systems design and development, as well as ongoing systems analysis as necessary
- Some examples of the activities this resource will be performing are the design and implementation of a broader business-oriented data model, as well as incorporation of additional data into CCA's enterprise data and reporting models

Background

State Blanket ITS77 – Staff Augmentation agreement through the Commonwealth of Massachusetts

- By relying on ITS77, the Health Connector receives the benefit of relying on a vendor procured through an appropriate process with all the strong contractual protections that come with a state contract
- Saves the Health Connector the time and resources of conducting a procurement for a staff augmentation vendor, without sacrificing the flexibility to choose the specific resource we need
- McInnis Consulting is an approved vendor that has been procured through state blanket ITS77
